

Library Fifth Grade Google Slide Autobiography Presentation

Overview: Students will prepare and present a Google Slide Autobiography. The presentation helps increase communication skills and gives students an additional avenue to present information.

Materials: Student computers with internet access.
Teacher computer with internet access that is attached to a projector.
Scanner for pictures (optional).

Instructions: Create a six slide autobiography with pictures inserted on at least two of the slides. The slides will appear in the following order: Title (your name), About Me (where and when you were born, places you have lived), Family (parents, siblings, pets), Favorite Things (what do you like), Places I've Been (favorite vacation spots), My Future (where are you going to middle school, what you want to be when you grow up). Try to follow the 6X6 rule (no more than 6 bullets per slide, no more than 6 words per bullet).
