Overview:

Students will explore their place and practice mapping skills by creating a map of their classroom using google drawing

Grades: K-5

Topic: Map Making/Social Studies

Materials: Access to computers/Google Drive

Students will have prior knowledge in the use of google drive/docs and how to login and access these features. Students will have prior knowledge of Ordinal directions and have practiced orienting themselves to these directions in the classroom.

Instruct students on the basics of map making by demonstrating making a map of the classroom on the whiteboard or SMART board if available in the classroom. Students will log into the their google account and access the <u>shared drawing file</u>. Students will save that file to their own google drive then edit it and create their own map of the classroom.
