Library Fifth Grade YouTube Assignment

Overview: Fifth graders will find a YouTube video demonstrating proper online behavior for their assigned topic and then create a Google Presentation to show the rest of the class what they have learned.

Materials: Student computers with internet access.

Presentation computer hooked up to a projector.

Instructions: Assign students a topic relating to netiquette (e.g., cyber bullying, data vandalism, e-mail, online manners and protocol). Students will research the topic on YouTube (at least 2 videos) and create a 6-8 slide Google Presentation to share the information they gathered to the rest of the class. Sources must be cited with URL and date viewed.

Resources: YouTube and Google Presentation

Rubric: 20 Points Possible

Finding 2 sources on YouTube 4 Points (2 points each). Restate information in a Google Presentation 8 Points.

Proper grammar and spelling 4 Points.

At least 6 slides 6 points (1 point each for first 6 slides).
