## **Library Fourth Grade Montana Research Project**

**Overview:** Students research assigned Montana location and create a three paragraph document describing the history of that location in Google Docs. They need to determine relevance of the information from both the internet and print sources that is used in the document.

Materials: Student computers with internet access.

Access to library materials.

**Instructions:** Using three sources (at least one print and digital source) students create a three paragraph document detailing the history of their assigned Montana location. Sources must be cited by Title, Author, Year Published.
