

Lesson Plan

Overview

This lesson plan is intended for High School Sophomores. It can be taught on its own or as the third class following [10th Grade Introduction to MTCIS Lesson Plan](#) and [10th Grade MTCIS Career Choice Lesson Plan](#). This lesson will help students research more information about the colleges and universities they are interested in attending to help them make more informed decisions about their future.

Materials

A computer lab large enough to accommodate a class of students

Instructions

1. Before students log on to their computers, Introduce the lesson by explaining to students that they will be using Google Search to research information about where they want to live after high school.
2. Start the lesson by showing students the [How Search Works](#) Info Website. Then, play the [Power Searching with Google Lesson 1.4](#) video.
3. Hand out the [College Google Research Worksheet](#) to students and give them the rest of the class period to start searching. Provide the students with an assignment deadline and instructions for turning in the paper.
4. Walk around room to assure students are on-task and to answer questions as needed. \
