Overview:

Junior students will use Google Maps to create a custom Google map of their preferred colleges. This map will serve as a baseline for looking at schools comparing not only what the school has to offer, but the community as a whole does as well.

Materials:

Internet capible device.

Resources:

Google Maps, Google Earth, Google Search

Instructions:

Using what you have learned in the previous Google search lesson, and the Google Map tutorial you just heard. I want each of you to create your own custom Google Map. On this map you will create pin points of potential schools you have considered applying to after you graduate from Hellgate. For each location I want you to insert a picture representing the city or the school. Under each picture you will also list at least three different reason why you want to attend that particular school, also, what major you are considering studying.

Rubric:

Students will have at least three choices created and will share the link with their counselor to be used in planning a college path.
