INSTRUCTIONS:

The English teacher's in the special education department at Big Sky High School adopted the writing curriculum "Step Up to Writing" years ago. Since then we have spent much time scaffolding the elements of the curriculum and creating formal and informal assessments to enhance this program.. Students are first introduced to the main organizational structure of expository/explanatory writing, the elements in each part, and then are taught to make connection between the elements and specific colors. After a two week introductory lesson on expository writing, I would check for understanding by scheduling the students to take a quiz in the computer lab using Google Docs. My quiz was made from the Forms.
