YouTube Life After High School Lesson Plan

Overview

In this lesson, students will start to prepare for life after high school. This lesson is designed for 11th grade students. It will focus on preparing for post-secondary education, vocational training, or searching for a job after high school.

Materials

Computer lab large enough to accommodate students
Printer

Instructions

- 1. Instruct students to choose a topic pertaining to preparing for life after high school. Each student needs to choose a different topic. Examples of topics: Completing the FAFSA, Choosing the right College, The Differences between 2 year and 4 year colleges, Preparing a Resume for a job, etc.
- 2. Students will search <u>www.youtube.com/edu</u> for an appropriate video relevant to the topic they chose.
- 3. Students will create a flyer or pamphlet highlighting the tips and tricks they learned about their topic. The flyer or pamphlet needs to include a short introduction to the topic and 5 tips, tricks, or suggestions for how to successfully complete this topic. The flyer or pamphlet will be create in GoogleDrive and shared with the class.
- 4. Students will present their topic to the class, including the YouTube video and Information flyer. This presentation should be 5-10 minutes in length and will include a question and answer session at the end.
- 5. Instruct students that they will be awarded points for participation during the question and answer session. Provide students with note cards so that they can write down relevant questions about presentations. They can turn in these questions for points if they don't get a chance to ask during the Q&A.
